YOUTH ENRICHMENT

Babysitter Training



This one-day course provides youth with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly give care for children and

infants. This training will help participants to develop leadership skills, learn how to develop a babysitting business, keep themselves and others safe and help children behave. Find answers to common babysitting questions like sibling squabbling and mealtime tips. The course also covers American Heart Association CPR, diaper duties, bedtime tips and much more.
